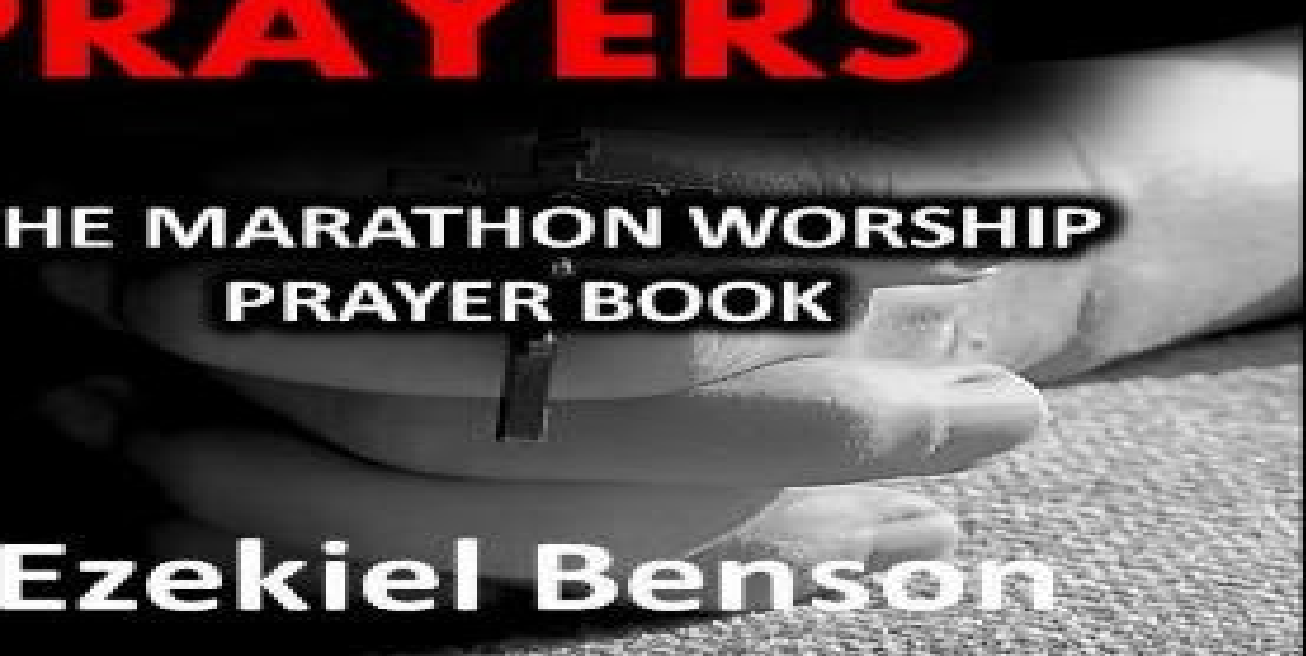

GOD'S MERCY: THE KEY THAT RELEASES ANSWERS TO PRAYERS

We have all prayed for one thing or the other, but there is no denying the fact that we have not all received answers to all our prayers.

Many have prayed for prosperity, success, deliverance from problems, healing, finances, fruit of the womb and all sorts, but sadly the answers to these prayers are taking forever in coming.

The problem in most cases is not with not knowing how to pray, but what to do to fully activate the power of God to get the answers to you.

I have discovered in my study of the scriptures and personal prayer life that the MERCY OF GOD is one ingredient component of prayer and worship that we neglect when we are making demands of our Heavenly Father.

You can get help quite early and on time for any situation or subject of prayer when you learn to focus your prayers and devotion to God on His Mercy that endures forever.

The Psalmist prayed

**"O satisfy us early with thy mercy;
that we may rejoice and be glad all
our days."- Psalms 90:14**

He understood the power of God's mercy and he gave attention to it in his prayers.

Satisfy us early with thy mercy implies quick solutions that are delivered on time, at the right place and at the right time.

The Psalmist also said:

**"He shall send from heaven, and
save me from the reproach of him
that would swallow me up. Selah.
God shall send forth his mercy and
his truth."- Psalms 57:3**

God only sends help from heaven to save and deliver because of His mercy.

Whatever help or response you need from God can be gotten by entreating his mercy. This also you must learn to do rightly in order to get results.

The Psalmist prayed the following:

**"Help me, O LORD my God: O
save me according to thy mercy:"-
Psalms 109:26**

Divine help is a product of God's intervening mercy. This means that we can get assured answers to our prayers if we can offer God Mercy Focused Worship and Prayers.

Offering God worship that was focused on his mercy produced victory, abundance and prosperity in the lives of the children of Israel.

The bible tells us that King Jehoshaphat in **2 Chronicles 20:1 - 25** conquered a whole formidable army of the enemy; they didn't need to fight in the battle; God fought for them and won the victory for them and *they were blessed with great spoils because they demonstrated their trust in the mercy of God!*

"And when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten. For the children of Ammon and Moab stood up against the inhabitants of mount Seir, utterly to slay and destroy them: and when they had made an end of the inhabitants of Seir, every one helped to destroy another.

And when Judah came toward the watch tower in the wilderness, they looked unto the multitude, and, behold, they were dead bodies fallen to the earth, and none escaped.

AND WHEN JEHOSHAPHAT AND HIS PEOPLE CAME TO TAKE AWAY THE SPOIL OF THEM, THEY FOUND

**AMONG THEM IN ABUNDANCE
BOTH RICHES WITH THE DEAD
BODIES, AND PRECIOUS JEWELS,
WHICH THEY STRIPPED OFF FOR
THEMSELVES, MORE THAN THEY
COULD CARRY AWAY: AND THEY
WERE THREE DAYS IN GATHERING
OF THE SPOIL, IT WAS SO MUCH. " –
2 Chronicles 20:22-23**

As the children of Israel trusted in God's mercy and worshipped Him because of his mercifulness, the Lord fought and won the battle for them; and blessed them with an abundance of spoils and riches which took them three days in carrying away to their country.

God's mercy not only wins battles for you, but it also releases an abundance of divine prosperity into your life; prosperity that is so much in abundance that you will not have enough room to contain.

The first implication of this spiritual fact is that God's mercy is loaded with so much unlimited power that it can do anything God desires it to do in a person's life.

The second implication of this is that we can take advantage of God's mercy in prayer, worship and devotion and through complete trust and heartfelt worship to God; we can activate it to release answers to our prayers and abundance of divine blessings, favours and prosperity to work on our behalf.

By the application of spiritual intelligence, a Christian should trust and hope in the God of all mercies and favours and express this trust in worship to God. It is our trust and hope in the Lord that releases divine mercies, favours and prosperity upon us and upon our path.

The book of **Psalms 33:18** declares:

Behold, the eye of the LORD is upon them that fear him, upon them that hope in his mercy;

In other words, God would only give attention to those who trust and hope in His Mercy.

When we trust and hope in the mercy of the Lord we become favoured and fruitful; prosperous and successful; blessed and loaded with divine goodness. This fact is seen in Psalms 52:8:

Psalms 52:8

But I am like a green olive tree in the house of God: I trust in the mercy of God for ever and ever.

It was the Psalmist trust in the mercy of God that made him like a green olive tree in the house of God.

Green Olive tree implies fruitfulness, prosperity, favour and all-round wellbeing. What produced it in the life of the Psalmist was *trust in the mercy of God forever!?*

Trust in the mercy of the Lord ought to be shown and demonstrated.

King Jehoshaphat in **2 Chronicles 20:1 - 25** conquered a whole formidable army of the enemy; they didn't need to fight in the battle; God fought for them and won the victory for them and they were blessed with great spoils because they demonstrated their trust in the mercy of God!

So the question that quickly comes to mind is "How Do I Demonstrate My Trust In The Mercy Of God?"

HOW DO WE DEMONSTRATE TRUST IN THE MERCY OF GOD!

There are several ways to demonstrate your trust in God's Mercy and one of the quickest ways of obtaining God's attention and the manifestation of God's mercy, favour, grace and power in your life and situation all the time is to deliberately offer God **MERCY FOCUSED WORSHIP!**

You can live a life of favour, mercy and grace everyday by offering God Mercy Focused Worship. When you start each day of your life by offering God Mercy Focused Worship, you will certainly obtain mercy, favour and grace at the time of your need.

Offering God Mercy Focused Worship makes every crooked way before you straight and creates an atmosphere for you to walk in divine mercy, favour and grace throughout that day. It produces a divine orchestrated attraction that causes men to line up on your way to help you; to support you; to favour you; to assist you and to bless you. Battles are won and God steps in to make sure you are always ahead and that you always have the advantage.

This book was written to help you get to this level in life. In the next chapters, I will be sharing with you what Mercy Focused Worship means; the Power of Mercy Focused Worship and how to activate it to produce favourable results in your life.

Many people don't know the power of activating the mercy of God to work for them. When God's mercy is stirred up, mighty works of power are wrought or performed in your favour; this includes great miracles, great healings, great salvation, release of abundant prosperity and victory in every battle of life.

When a situation seems impossible or too hard to overcome, one thing that can get the job done is God's Mercy fully activated.

EXAMPLES OF ACTIVATING THE MERCY OF GOD TO WORK WONDERS

King Jehoshaphat had a serious insurmountable problem. The children of Ammon and Moab and mount Seir with a great multitude of soldiers and mighty men of war came up to war against the children of Israel (2 Chronicles 20:1,2).

King Jehoshaphat had an insignificant number of warriors. The bible describes the enemy army of warriors as a "great multitude". This enemy army of warriors had the capacity to run down and squash King Jehoshaphat and his army of small soldiers. It could have led to a complete destruction of God's people.

The first reaction of the King when he heard of the impending destruction of his people was **FEAR!** The Bible says:

**"It came to pass after this also,
that the children of Moab, and
the children of Ammon, and with
them other beside the Ammonites,**

came against Jehoshaphat to battle. Then there came some that told Jehoshaphat, saying, There cometh a great multitude against thee from beyond the sea on this side Syria; and, behold, they be in Hazazontamar, which is Engedi.

AND JEHOSEPHAT FEARED....." 2
Chronicles 20:1-3

King Jehoshaphat feared because he knew deep down in his heart that there was no way he could win the war against the enemy army of warriors.

Life is often about facing and fighting battles. There are battles against sicknesses, diseases, poverty, death, stagnancy, childlessness, career problems, business failures, problems with spouse or children, etc. The list goes on and on.

Many are battling with problems they have never been able to overcome. Some have been racing for years with no finish line in sight. Many have given up on hope; many are no longer fighting because they have lost the same battle over and over again. They have prayed; they have been prayed for, but are nothing bettered.

King Jehoshaphat was at a point in the history of his life and reign as a king where he knew that he could not win the battle before him by his might or the strength of the army

of Israel. So he decided to seek the face of the Lord

**"And Jehoshaphat feared, and set himself to seek the LORD, and proclaimed a fast throughout all Judah. And Judah gathered themselves together, to ask help of the LORD: even out of all the cities of Judah they came to seek the LORD."
- 2 Chronicles 20:3-4.**

King Jehoshaphat prayed unto God; he presented the looming destruction of his people before God and asked for divine intervention and help from the Lord. (2 Chronicles 20: 5-13)

In response to his prayer and request for help, God spoke the following Words through his servant Zechariah.

"Then upon Jahaziel the son of Zechariah, the son of Benaiah, the son of Jeiel, the son of Mattaniah, a Levite of the sons of Asaph, came the Spirit of the LORD in the midst of the congregation; And he said, Hearken ye, all Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem, and thou king Jehoshaphat, Thus saith the LORD unto you, BE NOT AFRAID NOR DISMAYED BY REASON OF THIS GREAT MULTITUDE; FOR THE BATTLE IS NOT YOURS, BUT GOD'S. TO MORROW GO YE DOWN AGAINST

THEM: behold, they come up by the cliff of Ziz; and ye shall find them at the end of the brook, before the wilderness of Jeruel.

YE SHALL NOT NEED TO FIGHT IN THIS BATTLE: SET YOURSELVES, STAND YE STILL, AND SEE THE SALVATION OF THE LORD WITH YOU, O Judah and Jerusalem: FEAR NOT, NOR BE DISMAYED; TOMORROW GO OUT AGAINST THEM: FOR THE LORD WILL BE WITH YOU."- 2 Chronicles 20:14-17

God asked King Jehoshaphat and his people not to be afraid or dismayed by reason of the great multitude. In other words, though your problem be great and may look impossible to solve, **FEAR NOT!**

Despite the fact that King Jehoshaphat's army was nothing compared in size and might to the multitude of the enemies army of warriors, God encouraged and instructed King Jehoshaphat and his insignificant army to go out against them in battle. But they were not going to fight in that battle; God was going to do the fighting for them.

One striking thing about the whole story is that King Jehoshaphat upon hearing Gods Word, behaved as though he knew how to work the prophecy to get instant results. He knew something powerful – always miraculous happens anytime you give thanks and praise to God for his mercy endures forever.

King Jchoshaphat knew that there was power in activating the mercy of God.

2 Chronicles 20:21

And when he had consulted with the people, he appointed singers unto the LORD, and that should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army, and to say, Praise the LORD; for his mercy endureth for ever.

King Jehoshaphat's actions were deliberate. From consultations and history, he knew that battles are always won; victories are obtained; God intervenes and mighty miracles are wrought whenever one gives thanks and praise to God for his mercy endures forever. He put singers in front of the insignificant army of Israel to sing and chant **ONLY ONE SONG** from the city all through to the battle ground.

"Praise the Lord; for his mercy endured forever"

That was their song. They didn't get tired of singing it and they didn't change it. They kept at it; they sang and chanted those words from the city to the battle ground and as they did, God went to work and into action for them.

The bible makes us to understand that as the children of Israel sang and chanted **"Praise the Lord; for his mercy endures forever"**, the Lord set ambushments in the camp of the

enemy and destroyed every one of them to the last soldier.

"And when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten. For the children of Ammon and Moab stood up against the inhabitants of mount Seir, utterly to slay and destroy them: and when they had made an end of the inhabitants of Seir, every one helped to destroy another." – 2 Chronicles 20:22-23

King Jehoshaphat applied *Mercy Focused Thanksgiving and Praise* to God during warfare and the army of Israel never lifted up a finger in battle. God fought the war for them, obtained the victory for them and delivered the spoils into their hands.

WHAT IS MERCY FOCUSED WORSHIP, THANKSGIVING AND PRAISE?

MERCY FOCUSED WORSHIP, THANKSGIVING AND PRAISE is centered on giving praise and thanksgiving unto God because he is good and kind and his mercy endures forever. This kind of praise and worship is deliberate; your focus is God's mercy that endures forever. You can sing and chant "Praise the Lord; for his mercy endures forever" for several minutes to hours. It releases tremendous power that is dynamic in its working on your behalf to work for you. It makes power to change hands; it brings God in His fullness and power down into your situation, problems and battles to fight for you and obtain the victory for you.

I have discovered that miracles are almost wrought instantly when we deliberately give thanks and praise to God because his mercy endures forever.

Kind David also knew this secret of Mercy Focused Worship, Thanksgiving and Praise. That's why he deliberately created and set aside musical instruments just to praise the

Lord because his mercy endures forever. This fact is found in 2 Chronicles 7:6

2 Chronicles 7:6

And the priests waited on their offices: the Levites also with instruments of musick of the LORD, which David the king had made to praise the LORD, because his mercy endureth for ever, when David praised by their ministry; and the priests sounded trumpets before them, and all Israel stood.

I believe that when King Jehoshaphat was consulting with the people in 2 Chronicles 20:21, before they went out to the battle field, he was asking "How did King David and men of Old obtain great victories in battle? How did they prepare? What do they do before every battle or challenge? What was their ritual?"

The elderly ones and the priest amongst them would have told him that the secret to obtaining massive miracles and victory is to set aside quality time to activate the fullness of the power in the mercy of God by giving quality praise and thanks to Him because he is good and king and his mercy endures forever.

Massive miracles happen when we give praise and thanks to God because His mercy endures forever. No wonder David dedicated

the whole of Psalms 136 to give thanks and praise to God for his mercy endures forever.

The giving of thanks and praise unto the Lord because his mercy endures forever in **Psalms 136** is connected to God's mighty acts of power, miracles and deliverance. In other words giving thanks and praise to God for his mercy endures forever releases the miracle power of God for mighty signs and wonders.

PSALMS 136 is a Mercy Focused Worship, Thanksgiving and Praise Psalms and its content is linked to God's power, might, powerful exploits and wonders. It is also connected to God's power to save, deliver, care for and prosper his people. All these and more would Mercy Focused Worship, Thanksgiving and Praise activate and do for you.

We see the children of Israel engaging in Mercy Focused Worship, Thanksgiving and Praise to God in Ezra 3:11

Ezra 3:11

And they sang together by course in praising and giving thanks unto the LORD; because he is good, for his mercy endureth for ever toward Israel. And all the people shouted with a great shout, when they praised the LORD, because the foundation of the house of the LORD was laid.

From Ezra 3:11, you would discover that the children of Israel only sang songs that focused on the mercy of the Lord that endures forever. They understood the power of focusing on God's mercy in worship, thanksgiving and praise to him.

We can achieve greatness; change any situation; destroy every opposition; rise above limitations; prosper exceedingly and have massive and mighty miracles performed in our lives if we understand the power in Mercy Focused worship and give quality time to engage effectively in it.

WHAT MERCY FOCUSED WORSHIP, THANKSGIVING AND PRAISE WOULD DO FOR YOU.

1.

God's Glory and Power (The Cloud of God's Presence) would fill your life and step into your situation.

This is a process where God inhabits your praises and intervenes in your situation. This fact is seen in **2 Chronicles 5:13** when the cloud of the Lord's Presence filled the temple when the singers and the children of Israel chanted and sang the same song: "Praise the Lord; for he is good; for his mercy endures forever"

2.

Power Changes Hands And God Takes Over Your Battles And Obtains Massive Victory For You.

This fact is seen in 2 Chronicles 20:14-17

**"Thus saith the LORD unto you,
BE NOT AFRAID NOR DISMAYED
BY REASON OF THIS GREAT MUL-
TITUDE; FOR THE BATTLE IS NOT**

**YOURS, BUT GOD'S. YE SHALL
NOT NEED TO FIGHT IN THIS BAT-
TLE: SET YOURSELVES, STAND YE
STILL, AND SEE THE SALVATION
OF THE LORD WITH YOU...."- 2
Chronicles 20:14-17**

3.

Massive Miracles Are Wrought Or Performed
For You

No matter what the situation in your life may be, engaging in and giving quality time to Mercy Focused Worship, Thanksgiving and Praise will make the tremendous power of God that is dynamic in its working available to perform mighty miracles in your life and situation.

The miracle of victory King Jehoshaphat had over the enemies' army was almost instant. It was a sure victory; it was a sure miracle. There was this certainty of victory and it was obvious for all to see.

- **Have you prayed and fasted like King Jehoshaphat prayed and yet there is no tangible result?**
- **Do you desire divine healing; blessing of the fruit of the womb; a change in your finances, business and career; or to turn a hopeless situation around for good?**
- **Have you been racing for years without no finish line in sight?**

- **Have you fought this battle and have lost severally – all the time and are about to throw in the towel?**
- **Are you wondering what else can I do to get the desired miracle?**

The answer is in **Mercy Focused Worship, Thanksgiving and Praise**. Dedicate quality time and some days or weeks just to give God praise and thanks because his mercy endures forever and you would see the miracle power of God go to work on your behalf to give you the needed victory and miracle.

This is why I have written this book; to provide you with content for Mercy Focused Worship, Thanksgiving and Praise unto God because His mercy endured forever. The Mercy Focused content in this book are powerful mercy based scriptures that are directed at praise and thanksgiving to God and they are able to give you the needed victory when used effectively in prayer and worship to God

4.

Gives Joy and Gladness

When you set aside quality time to engage effectively Mercy Focused Worship, Thanksgiving and Praise because His mercy endures forever, you will have and experience joy and gladness. This is seen in Jeremiah 33:11:

Jeremiah 33:11

The voice of joy, and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom, and the voice of the bride, the voice of them that shall say, Praise the LORD of hosts: for the LORD is good; for his mercy endureth for ever

From Jeremiah 33:11, you would discover that those who "shall say, praise the Lord of Hosts: for the Lord is good; for his mercy endureth forever" shall have joy and gladness.

Joy and gladness comes when assurance of victory is given or when you have seen, received and experienced the victory or miracle. Jeremiah 33:11 actually points to the certainty of a miracle taking place that would lead to joy and gladness.

Mercy Focused Worship, Thanksgiving and Praise to God because he is good and kind and because his mercy endures forever gives the guaranty and certainty of a definite miracle happening which would lead to joy and gladness.

5.

Leads to Massive Manifestation and Demonstration of God's Power

When you set aside quality time to engage in Mercy Focused Worship, Thanksgiving and Praise to God, it leads to massive manifestation and demonstration of God's power.

King Solomon engaged in Mercy Focused
Worship of God in 2 Chronicles 6:14

**"And said, O LORD God of Israel,
there is no God like thee in the
heaven, nor in the earth; which
keepest covenant, and shewest
mercy unto thy servants, that walk
before thee with all their hearts: " –
2 Chronicles 6:14**

He offered God worship and praise making
reference to his mercy and from there on
made his desires known unto him.

This result of King Solomon's Mercy Focused
Worship, Thanksgiving and Praise of God is
seen in 2 Chronicles 7:3.

**2 Chronicles 7:3
And when all the children of Is-
rael saw how the fire came down,
and the glory of the LORD upon
the house, they bowed themselves
with their faces to the ground upon
the pavement, and worshipped,
and praised the LORD, saying, For
he is good; for his mercy endureth
for ever.**

There was a massive manifestation and
demonstration of the power of God in form
of the fire and the glory of God that came
upon the house of the Lord.

This great manifestation and demonstration of Gods power drew further Mercy Focused Worship and Praise of God from the children of Israel and they bowed themselves with their faces to the ground upon the temple pavement and worshiped God saying **“For he is good; for his mercy endures forever”**.

HOW TO ENGAGE IN MERCY FOCUSED WORSHIP, THANKSGIVING AND PRAISE OF GOD

1. Sing and Chant

Sing and chant songs that declares that God is good and kind and his mercy endures forever

2. Declare and Chant Scriptures

Declare and chant scriptures that give praise and thanks to God for his mercies endure forever.

3. Create Your Own Psalms

You can use several combination of scriptures mixed with your own words to create your own psalms that gives praise and thanks to God because He is good and kind and His mercy endures forever.

4. Word-Of-God Based Confessions

You can also get several scriptures about God's mercy enduring forever and scriptures about the great and mighty miracle acts God performed as a result of the show of his

mercy; and use them to give praise to God and make mercy-based prophetic declarations over your life.

5. Dedicate Time

If you have a serious issue that needs divine intervention, I recommend that you dedicate a day or days in a week to engage in Mercy Focused Worship.

You can combine this exercise with fasting and prayer.

You can dedicate a whole week, month or months just to offer God Mercy Focused Worship. You could precede your prayer time with Mercy Focused Worship or end your prayer sessions with it.

To keep the mercy of God always activated and at work in your life, have a day or days in a week dedicated to offering God only Mercy Focused Worship, Thanksgiving and Praise.
